# MUSIC MATERIALS



This is a list of materials I use most often for students from beginner level through high school. It is not meant to be all-inclusive Good sources for music are Amazon.com and Sharmusic.com. Cellos2go.com sells cello music and accessories for cello.

<u>Students will use the Suzuki Books as the basis of their repertoire through book 8.</u> The later books include many of the traditional short pieces for cello. Supplemental solos will be added along the way and these are listed alphabetically by composer.

<u>After completing Suzuki Book 8, the student will move on to concerti, solo Bach, sonatas, etc.</u> (The Suzuki editions of the Haydn C major concerto in book 9 and the Goltermann Concerto in Bb in book 10 are not used)

<u>Carl Schroeder Etude Books will be used to establish the basis of music reading in the bass clef in book 1, the tenor clef in book 2 and the treble clef in book 3.</u>

Scale work will start in Schroeder book 1 with two octave scales and then eventually progress to the Galamian Scale System using more octaves with varied rhythms and bowings.
